

## Various Allusions and Cross References for Revelation 12:7–12

### Verse 7

James 4:1 Where do wars and fights *come* from among you? Do *they* not *come* from your *desires* for pleasure that war in your members?

Daniel 10:13, 21 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia.

<sup>21</sup> But I will tell you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth. (No one upholds me against these, except Michael your prince.

Daniel 12:1-2 “At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands *watch* over the sons of your people;

And there shall be a time of trouble,  
Such as never was since there was a nation,  
*Even* to that time.

And at that time your people shall be delivered,  
Every one who is found written in the book.

<sup>2</sup> And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake,  
Some to everlasting life,  
Some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.

Exodus 15:11 “Who *is* like You, O LORD, among the gods?

Who *is* like You, glorious in holiness,  
Fearful in praises, doing wonders?

Psalms 89:6-8 For who in the heavens can be compared to the LORD?

Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened to the LORD?

<sup>7</sup> God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints,  
And to be held in reverence by all *those* around Him.

<sup>8</sup> O LORD God of hosts,  
Who *is* mighty like You, O LORD?  
Your faithfulness also surrounds You.

Jude 9 Yet Michael the archangel, in contending with the devil, when he disputed about the body of Moses, dared not bring against him a reviling accusation, but said, “The Lord rebuke you!”

(cf. James 5:14-15 and Zechariah 3:1-4)

### Verse 9

Genesis 3:1, 4 Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden’?”

<sup>4</sup> Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die.

Genesis 3:14-15 So the LORD God said to the serpent:

“Because you have done this,  
You *are* cursed more than all cattle,  
And more than every beast of the field;  
On your belly you shall go,  
And you shall eat dust  
All the days of your life.

<sup>15</sup> And I will put enmity  
Between you and the woman,  
And between your seed and her Seed;  
He shall bruise your head,  
And you shall bruise His heel.”

Job 1:6-12 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them. <sup>7</sup> And the LORD said to Satan, “From where do you come?” So Satan answered the LORD and said, “From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking back and forth on it.”

<sup>8</sup> Then the LORD said to Satan, “Have you considered My servant Job, that *there is* none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil?”

<sup>9</sup> So Satan answered the LORD and said, “Does Job fear God for nothing? <sup>10</sup> Have You not made a hedge around him, around his household, and around all that he has on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land. <sup>11</sup> But now, stretch out Your hand and touch all that he has, and he will surely curse You to Your face!”

<sup>12</sup> And the LORD said to Satan, “Behold, all that he has *is* in your power; only do not lay a hand on his *person*.”

So Satan went out from the presence of the LORD.

Job 2:1-7 Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them to present himself before the LORD. <sup>2</sup> And the LORD said to Satan, “From where do you come?”

Satan answered the LORD and said, “From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking back and forth on it.”

<sup>3</sup>Then the LORD said to Satan, “Have you considered My servant Job, that *there is* none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil? And still he holds fast to his integrity, although you incited Me against him, to destroy him without cause.”

<sup>4</sup>So Satan answered the LORD and said, “Skin for skin! Yes, all that a man has he will give for his life. <sup>5</sup>But stretch out Your hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will surely curse You to Your face!”

<sup>6</sup>And the LORD said to Satan, “Behold, he *is* in your hand, but spare his life.”

<sup>7</sup>So Satan went out from the presence of the LORD, and struck Job with painful boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head.

Luke 10:18 And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.

*(cf. Revelation 11:2)*

## Verse 10

Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

*(cf. Revelation 11:15)*

## Verse 11

John 1:11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

John 12:25 He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
